Selection process

- Submit your photo with the entry form (making sure you meet the criteria in FULL to be eligible).
- The Goulburn Hospital Arts & Heritage Committee will assess submissions and create a shortlist of finalists.
- Winning artist / artists will be selected by the Goulburn Hospital Arts & Heritage Committee and will be notified by Friday 27 November 2020.
- Winning photograph/s will be installed in readiness for the opening of the new Hospital in October 2021.



Photo Competition

Purpose

- To embed the hospital as valuable to civic and district life, reflecting community stories, heritage and future aspirations; and
- To provide an atmosphere that is calm, uplifting and hopeful.

Selection criteria

The Goulburn Hospital and Health Service Redevelopment Photo Competition is open to people who are living, working or visiting the Goulburn Mulwaree Council, Upper Lachlan Shire and Yass Valley Council Local Government Areas (LGA).

- The photograph must be from the last two years.
- The artwork will be displayed in a location as determined by the Arts & Heritage Committee.
- The image must be accompanied by full image credits and the application form completed in full for each entry.
- Images and photographer statement will respond to the core aims of arts integration noted above, with a specific focus on celebrating the Goulburn district's native flora, specifically boronia, wattle, lilac, bluebell and eucalyptus, and rainbow theme for Paediatrics.
- Photographers may wish to express themselves within the boundaries of the colours of the flowers or in capturing a rainbow theme.
- All works submitted for the competition must be original works taken by the person who is entering the competition.
- A maximum of 10 photos can be entered by each person.
- Shortlisted and winning images must be high resolution. Whilst the image to enter the competition is not to exceed 1mB, the size of the original image must be greater than 300dpi (at 1: 1 scale) to be suitably enlarged.

Applicants should be aware

- The image will be scaled to large wall format.
- Some elements of the image may be altered to suit environmental conditions such as light and power fittings, furniture and equipment.
- Consideration should be given to plant feature details and provide depth of field variation. Due to competing design elements in some areas, applicants are strongly encouraged to submit images that include multiple bud, flower and/or leaf details of a single species only.
- The Hospital reserves the right to place all images on social media.
- Selected images will be attributed to the photographer.
- The greatest possible care will be taken of all image files received but no liability will be accepted for the loss or damage to any entry.
- Images will not be returned to the applicant unless by prior arrangement.
- The decision of the Judges regarding the winners will be final. In the event of any other dispute, the ruling of the Health Services Manager shall be final.
- There is no entry fee to enter the competition, nor will fees be paid to applicants for their time or use of images or other related costs to enter the competition.
- The winning photographer/s will receive \$500 +GST (if applicable), payable upon tax invoice.
- We reserve the right not to proceed with this competition without prior consultation.

- The deadline for photograph submissions is **5:00pm, Friday 30 October 2020**.

Size and format

- **Mobile phone images will not be eligible**
- Only JPEG files will be accepted for competition entry
- The file size to enter the competition is not to exceed 1mb and/or ensure min 300dpi at 1:1 scale resolution quality
- **The size of the original image must be greater than 30mb**

Copyright

- Participants own the copyright of their work.
- The participant will grant Goulburn Hospital permission to reproduce, publish, or display the image of the work online (including media) or in publications and for printing to display.
- Images might also be shown in electronic media in Goulburn Hospital or printed on large photo murals.
- All necessary attribution will be made.
- Use of the image by the photographer shall attribute the Goulburn Hospital, subject to separate agreement.

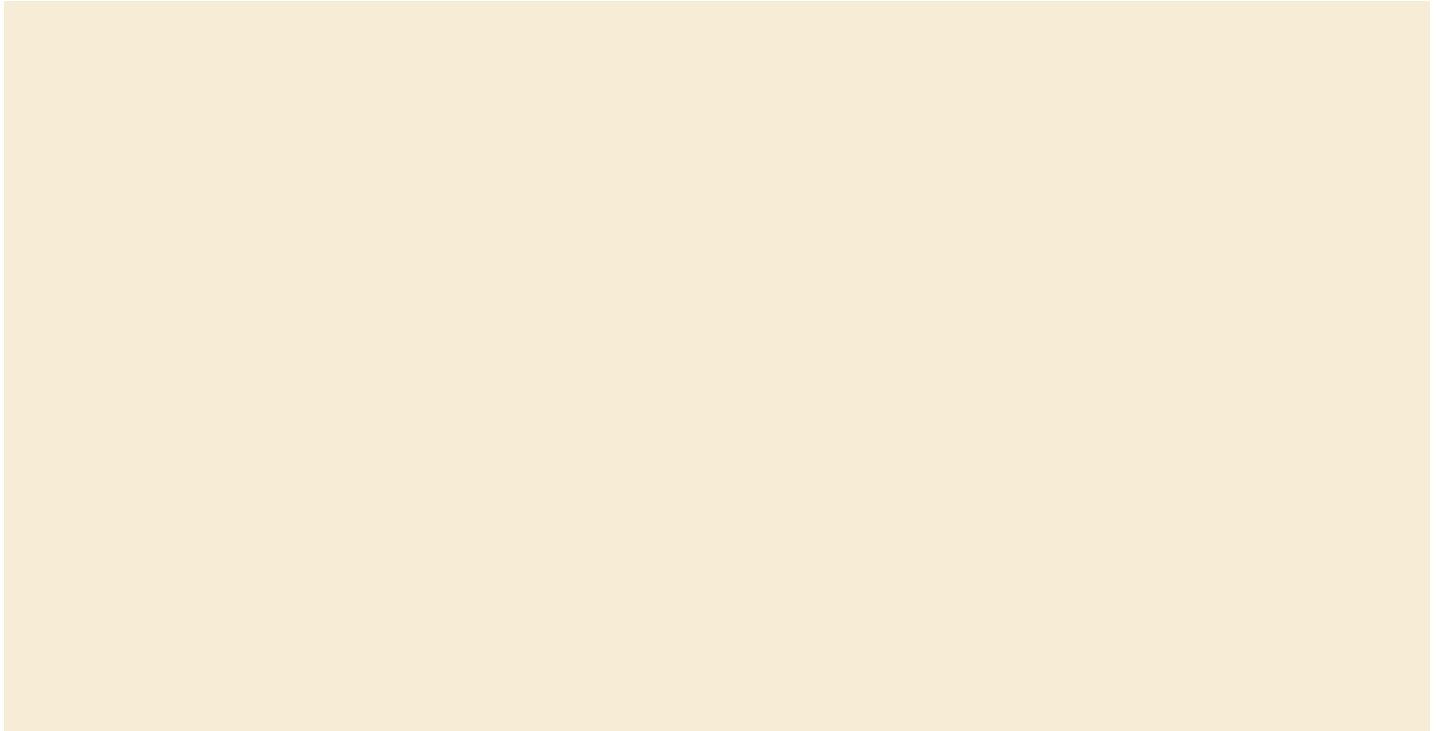
