### **Project up in lights**

The new Clinical Services Building (CSB) is well and truly on track for completion later this year, with the Lower Ground, Ground and Level One floors all undergoing their initial builders clean.

On Thursday 22 July installation of the Goulburn Base Hospital sky sign commenced, with the contractors braving the icy conditions to mark the exciting milestone for the project.

On Wednesday 28 July the Coreten steel art piece was installed outside the main entrance, providing a striking motif designed by local Aboriginal school children, for hospital users to enjoy.

On Friday 30 July an enthusiastic group of volunteers from the Goulburn Rose Society, students from Goulburn High School and the redevelopment project team put their green thumbs to work in the winter sunshine and began to preserve and relocate approximately 30 memorial roses.

Rose relocation will continue over the coming weeks. The roses will be replanted onsite in the front semi-circle garden and will remain a key feature of Goulburn Base Hospital, complementing the hospital garden's design.

The emergency department carpark, main entrance and central courtyard will also continue to take shape as we approach completion.
